Major Topics

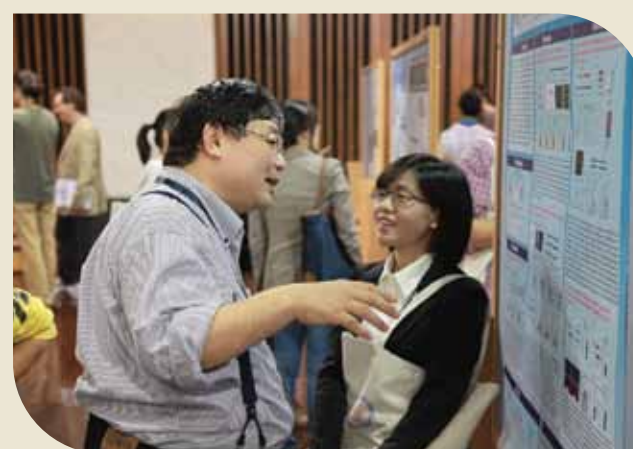
1. Development and Genetics of Neural Circuits
